

FEP BLUE FOCUS NON-FORMULARY DRUGS

FEP Blue Focus covers certain drugs — mainly generics and some Preferred brand name and specialty drugs. It doesn't cover all FDA-approved drugs. This is what's known as a "closed formulary."

FEP Blue Focus Option "Non-Formulary" drugs are excluded from coverage but have available covered options in the same therapeutic class.

If you're currently taking a prescription, you should check to see if your drug is covered under this plan. You can also view the full approved drug list at fepblue.org/formulary. If your drug is not on the approved drug list, you'll pay the full cost of the drug.

FEP BLUE FOCUS NON-FORMULARY EXCEPTION (NFE) PROCESS

The Non-Formulary Exception (NFE) process allows a member to apply for coverage of a "Non-Formulary Covered" drug if the member has tried and failed the covered drug(s). If your drug requires prior approval, you must meet the prior approval requirements in order for us to cover the drug. You can download the prior approval form for the drug [here](#).
