Introduction: This pharmacy directory search tool provides a list of Clover Health's network pharmacies. To get a complete description of your prescription coverage, including how to fill your prescriptions, please review the Evidence of Coverage and Clover Health's formulary.

When this pharmacy directory refers to "we," "us", or "our," it means Clover Health. When it refers to "plan" or "our plan," it means Clover Health.

We call the pharmacies on this list our "network pharmacies" because we have made arrangements with them to provide prescription drugs to plan enrollees. In most cases, your prescriptions are covered under Clover Health only if they are filled at a network pharmacy or through our mail order pharmacy service. Once you go to one pharmacy, you are not required to continue going to the same pharmacy to fill your prescription but can switch to any other of our network pharmacies. We will fill prescriptions at non-network pharmacies under certain circumstances as described in your Evidence of Coverage.

Retail Pharmacies, including Chain Pharmacies

You can get prescription drugs shipped to your home through our network mail order delivery program.

If you have used mail order services with your current plan before, or if you opt in now, our pharmacy will automatically fill and ship-new prescriptions received directly from your doctors or other prescribers. You may opt out of automatic deliveries of new prescriptions at any time by contacting CVS Caremark Customer Care at 1-855-479-3657 (PPO plans) or 1-844-232-2316 (HMO plans). If you never had mail order delivery and/or decide to stop automatic fills of new prescriptions, we will contact you each time we get a new prescription from a provider, to see if you want the medication filled and shipped at that time. This will give you an opportunity to make sure that the correct drug (including strength, amount, and form) will be delivered, and, if necessary, allow you to cancel or delay the order before you are billed and it is shipped.

For refills of your mail order prescriptions, you have the option to sign up for an automatic refill program. Under this program, we will start to process your next refill automatically when our records show that you should be close to running out of your drug. We will contact you prior to shipping each refill to make sure you are in need of more medication. You can cancel scheduled refills if you have enough of your medication or if your medication has changed. If you choose not to use the auto refill program, please contact us 15 (fifteen) days before you think the drugs you have on hand will run out to make sure your next order is shipped to you in time. To opt out of the automatic refill program, please contact us by logging in to your caremark.com or by calling CVS Caremark Customer Care at 1-855-479-3657 (PPO plans) or 1-844-232-2316 (HMO plans).

Typically, you should expect to receive your prescription drugs within 10 (ten) calendar days from the time that the mail order pharmacy receives the order. If you do not receive your prescription drug(s) within this time, please contact us by calling CVS Caremark Customer Care at 1-855-479-3657 (PPO plans) or 1-844-232-2316 (HMO plans). You can register for an online account at caremark.com so you can order refills, check your order status and start new prescription requests.

Let your doctor know you are using CVS Caremark Mail Service Pharmacy and ask them to send an electronic prescription (e-prescribe) directly to:

Home Infusion Pharmacies

Long-Term Care Pharmacies

- Distance (mi) column will provide estimated distance from the zip code or city and state and mile radius you entered in your search criteria. Click on View Map or Get Directions to get a map and directions from your search location to the pharmacy you have selected
