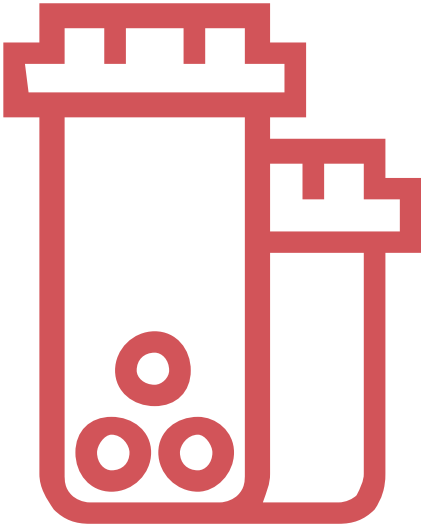

# Plan Design

# Your Coinsurance or Copayment

The amount you pay for your covered medications depends on the type of medication (generic, brand, or specialty) and where you fill your prescriptions.

Acute and Maintenance Medications	Obtained at CVS Retail Pharmacy locations or CVS Mail Service Pharmacy	Obtained at a Participating Non-CVS Retail Pharmacy location
Up to a 30-day supply	Generic : \$7  Brand Name : 20% cost of drug (Maximum \$75)	
31 to 60-day supply	Generic : \$14  Brand Name : 20% cost of drug (Maximum \$150)	
84 to 90-day supply	Generic : \$14  Brand Name : 20% cost of drug (Maximum \$150)	Generic : \$21  Brand Name : 20% cost of drug (Maximum \$225)



NOTE: The maximum copay per 30-day supply of insulin is \$50. \$0 copay applies to diabetic test strips and lancets.

# Specialty Medications

*Note: Specialty medications must be filled through CVS Specialty pharmacy after the initial fill at a participating retail pharmacy.*

Up to a 30-day supply	Generic : \$7  Brand Name : 20% cost of drug (Maximum \$75)

## Maximum Out-of-Pocket

*Once your out-of-pocket expenses reach the specified levels below, the Plan will pay covered charges at 100% for the remainder of the calendar year.*

**Individual:** \$ 1,500

**Family:** \$ 3,000



# Generics save you up to 80%

## Generic medications work just like brand-name equals

A generic has the same active ingredients, strength and dosage as its brand name equal. It provides the same quality and performance. Generics don't have high development costs.<sup>2</sup> That's why they cost you less.

## Generics are safe

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) requires generics to be as safe and effective as brand name equals. Both types of medication must meet the same FDA standards.<sup>2</sup>

## Here's how to save with generics

**Current prescriptions:** Ask your provider or pharmacist if you can replace your brand name medication with a generic.

**New prescriptions:** Ask your provider if there's a generic option.

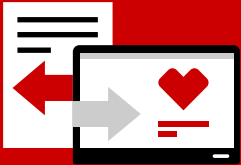

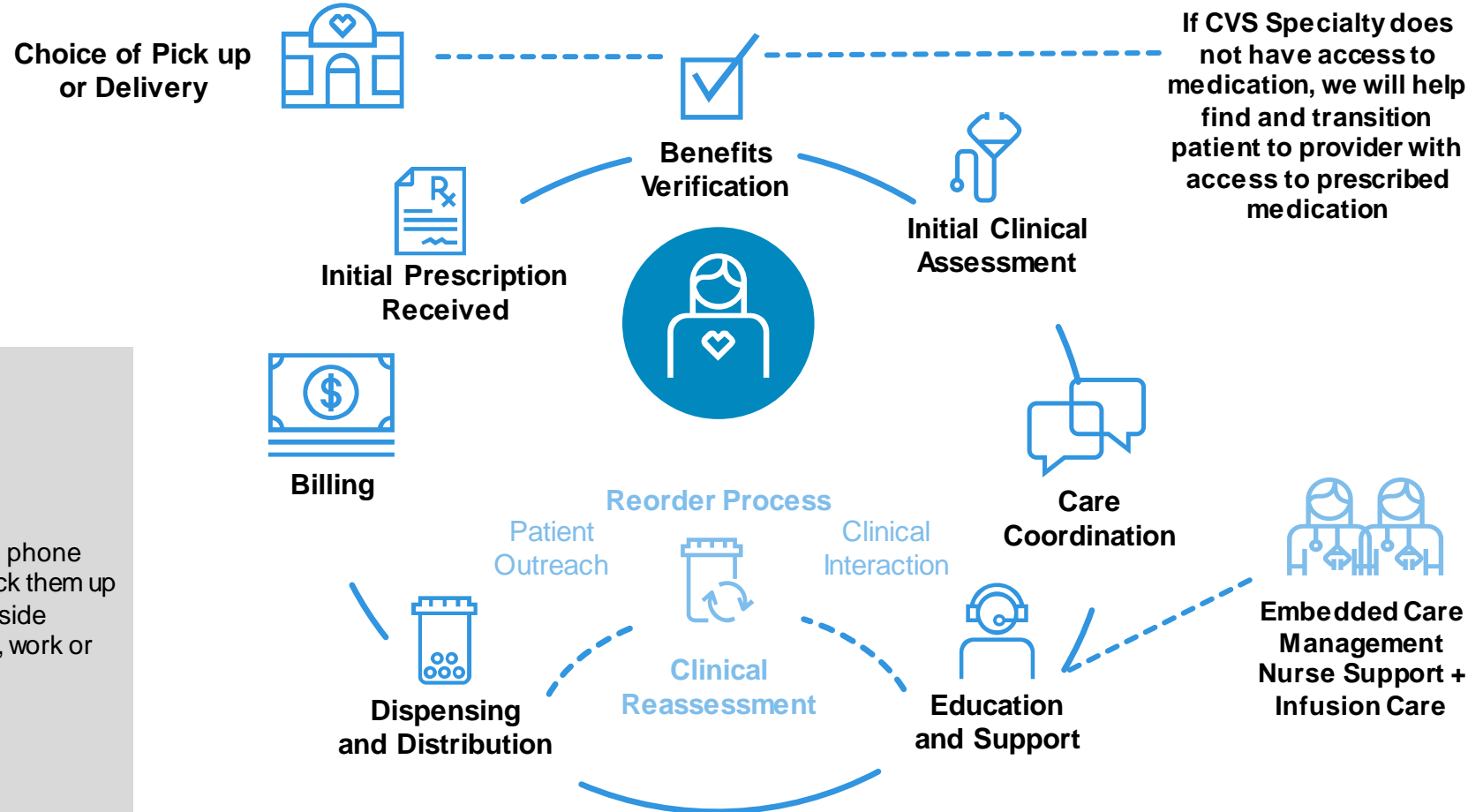

- Can register with or without their member ID



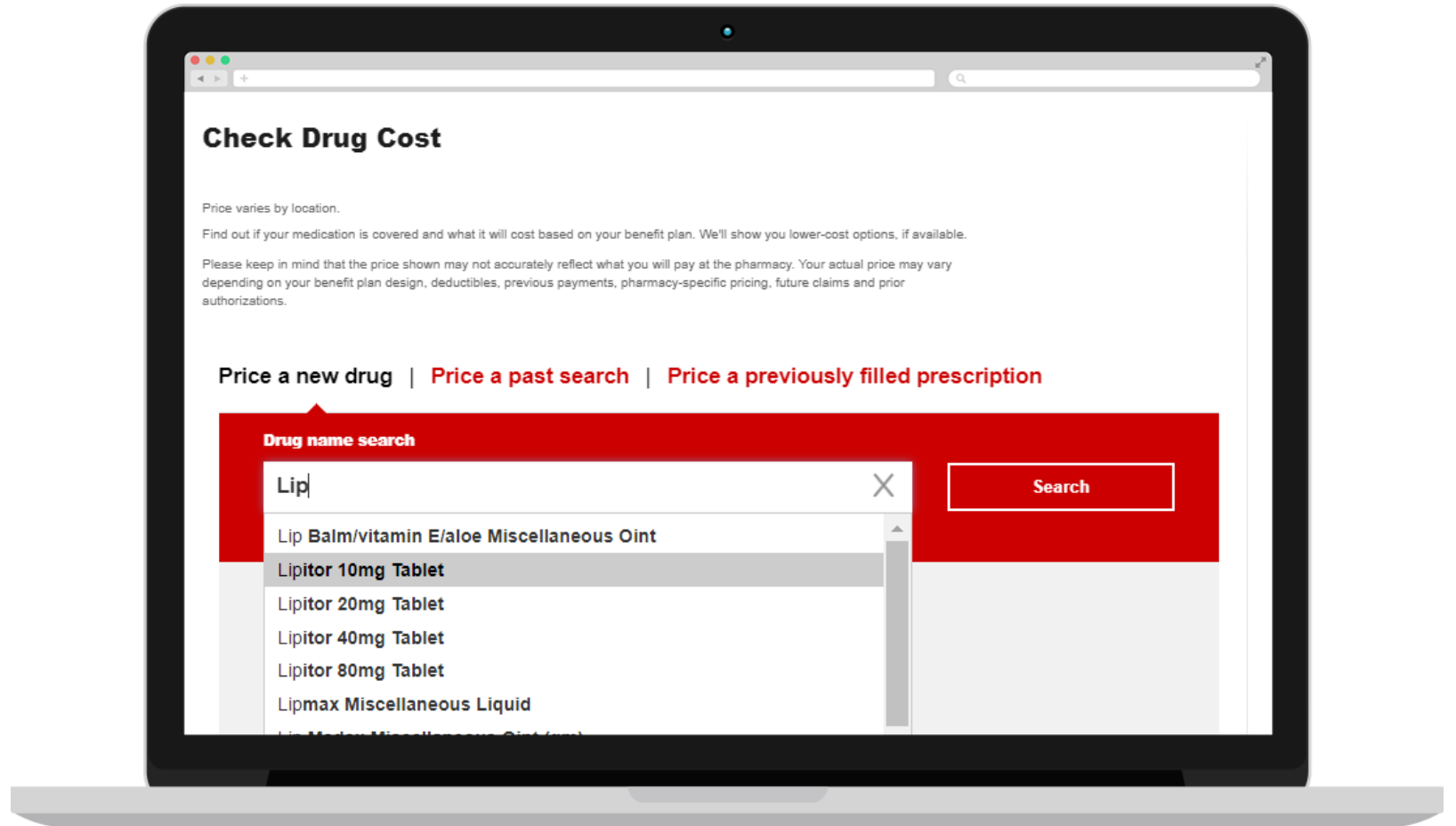
# Pharmacy locator

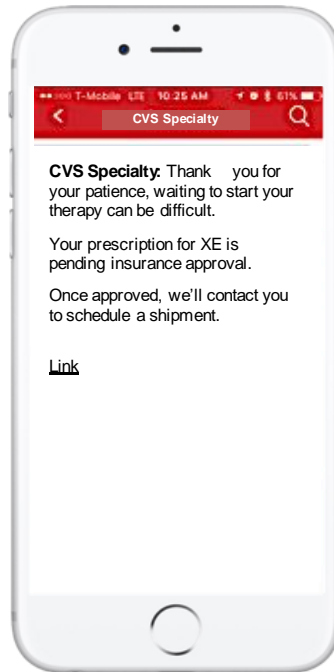
- View Member ID Card means members always have access to the information needed to submit a claim
- The Pharmacy Locator uses the mobile device's geo locator to make finding the nearest network pharmacy as easy as a click



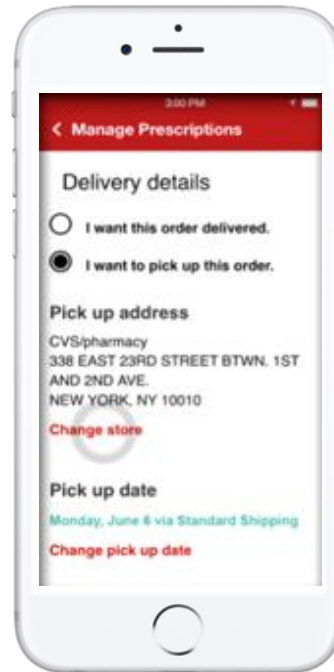

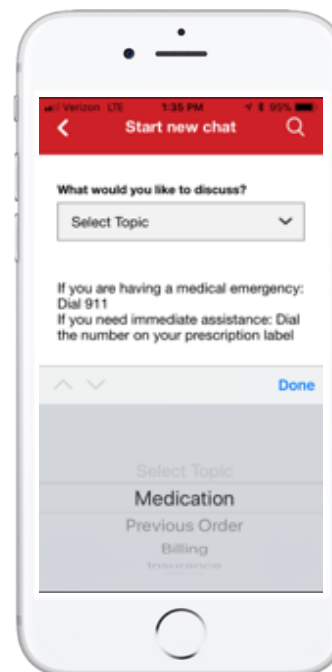

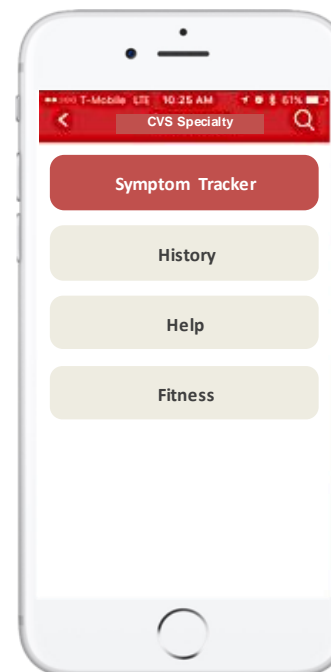
