Q1: Does the meter cost me anything?

A1: No. Blood glucose meters will be provided to all benefit eligible plan members and their covered dependents who meet the coverage requirements at no cost to the member.

Q2: Which meters and test strips will be covered?

A2: Covered meters include:

- Accu-Chek Guide Me
- OneTouch Verio Reflect
- OneTouch Verio Flex
